

CHARITIES UPDATE SEMINAR

We will be hosting a breakfast seminar covering recent changes affecting Registered Charities.

This will take place in Leicester on Thursday 20 March 2008 and will focus on the key changes in the Charities Act 2006, and other recent developments.

It will feature presentations by John Calow, Partner of Thomas May and David Gallagher, charity specialist and lecturer with Mercia Group Limited.

The seminar, being held at Möbius in Braunstone Gate will, amongst other topics, consider the effect that the changes will have on the trustees report, the statement of financial activities and on revenue recognition.

John Calow said: “Over a relatively short period of time, the charities sector has been affected by the introduction of a revised SORP, a new Charities Act and various pronouncements from the Charity Commission.

“This seminar will provide charities with a useful and timely update on these changes.”
